Covid-19 Support... Please see below information regarding coronavirus support, including how to apply for the 'Test & Trace Support Payment Scheme' and registering for food vouchers across the Easter Holiday...

Test & Trace Support Payment Scheme: Who can apply? You might be able to get a payment of £500 if you've been told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace, or **you're the parent or guardian of a child** who has been told to self-isolate. If you're eligible for either the Test and Trace Support Payment or a discretionary payment, you'll receive the £500 payment in addition to any benefits and Statutory Sick Pay that you receive currently.

Contact Tracing over the Easter Holiday... To support the NHS Test and Trace process, the government has asked school leaders to be available for the first 6 days of the Easter holiday to fulfil necessary contact tracing responsibilities. What does this mean? This means, we ask any member of our Viking family (staff member or child) to inform Miss Arthur (Upton), Mr Budge (RAPS) or Mrs Law (Chilton) of a positive case... IF either coronavirus symptoms or a positive home LFD test occurred within 2 days of the last day of term (Thursday 1st April). The school will then be required to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in their education setting.

Covid-19 safety measures... Lateral flow tests for families: please read the information below...

Testing for parents and households of staff and pupils Parents and other adults in households with children or staff at nursery, who do not have symptoms, can now also access regular, rapid coronavirus (COVID-19) testing. This includes childcare and support bubbles. There are different ways for a household, childcare or support bubble to collect or order their test to take at home, twiceweekly.

Testing is voluntary but **strongly recommended to all who are eligible**. Alongside the vaccine, washing hands, wearing face coverings, and maintaining social distancing, rapid testing plays a vital role in reducing transmission rates. Getting into the habit of regular testing as part of our everyday lives will help us all to play our part and do what we can to protect each other.
